Here are the details:

- **Orders will be taken until May 10th**
- **Trout will be forfeited if they are not picked up during the allotted time frame.**
- **6-8" Fish will need to be picked up at Agway in Brattleboro at 1:00 pm on May 15th**
- **10-12" Fish - Due to the cost of fuel, deliveries will be made in coordination with the supplier and the District. No set day or time can be made in advance. We will notify you on the day of anticipated delivery. Please include cell phone numbers (if available) so we can work together to make these deliveries in a timely manner.**

Before stocking, check your pond for suitability for trout. Water depth should be at least 8 feet. (This can be measured with a weighted rope.) Your pond's water should be clear (clear enough, for example, to see a white 10" diameter object at a depth of 6 feet or more.) And the bottom temperature in the summer shouldn't exceed 68 degrees F. Rainbows can tolerate warmer water than brook trout.

Please enclose a detailed map showing directions to your property and pond. Recording landmarks, house numbers and house colors help greatly. If you have had deliveries in the past we retain the maps but current maps are appreciated.

Notes for 2010 Trout Stocking Program

If you are requesting a delivery of trout to your pond you need to provide a detailed map showing directions to your property and pond. Our suppliers do not live in Windham County. They need route numbers, names of roads and estimated mileage from major intersections. Some of the maps that have been submitted to us are not accurate enough for the suppliers to find your pond and much time is lost back tracking to locate pond sites. Remember to flag the pond if you have more than one pond on your property. Please include a cell phone number (if possible) on your order form. We hope to have a District Supervisor ride along with the drivers to assist with directions but you need to do your part in helping us find your pond without undue delays. Trout not delivered can not be returned to the trout farm facility.

If you are picking up your trout at Agway, they will need to be picked up promptly at 1:00pm. Trout, once bagged can not be returned to the fish tank. Trout will be forfeited if they are not picked up during the allotted time frame. Please note the delivery day on your calendar as we will not be calling you individually to remind you of the pick up date.

In case of an emergency and you can not get your fish, call the District Office at 802-254-5323 Ext. 104. I will check for messages that morning. Please make a copy of your order form so you know what you have ordered.
